RULES AND DESCRIPTIONS

NO CROSS ENTRY OF HORSE/HANDLER COMBO BETWEEN *HALTER* AND *SHOWMANSHIP*. UNLESS YOU HAVE A YOUNG HORSE (DESIGNATED AS 3 YEARS OR YOUNGER THAT IS NOT BEING RIDDEN IN ANY CLASS) – YOU CAN DO BOTH!

NO CROSS ENTRY OF HORSE FROM *RANCH* TO *WESTERN PLEASURE*.

RANCH HORSES ARE ALLOWED TO ENTER WESTERN EQUITATION CLASSES AND HORSEMANSHIP (CLASSES 63-78)

GREEN (HORSE) IS ANY HORSE WHO HAS NOT BEEN SHOWN MORE THAN 2 YEARS. CROSS ENTRY ALLOWED.

NOVICE (RIDER) NOVICE IS DEFINED AS A RIDER WHO HAS LESS THAN 2 YEARS OF SHOWING EXPERIENCE. A RIDER WITH AN EXTENDED BREAK (5+ YEARS) IN RIDING THAT IS NOW BACK ALSO QUALIFIES FOR NOVICE. YOU CAN BE NOVICE IN WESTERN AND NON-NOVICE IN ENGLISH OR THE OTHER WAY AROUND. CROSS ENTRY ALLOWED BETWEEN WESTERN & ENGLISH. NOVICE MUST SHOW IN NOVICE ONLY DESIGNATED CLASSES IN THAT DISCIPLINE.

SERIES HALTER CHAMPIONSHIP CLASS WILL HAVE A SPECIAL CLASS AT FINAL AUGUST SHOW WITH ALL HALTER CHAMPION AND RESERVE HALTER CHAMPION WINNERS FROM JUNE, JULY, AND AUGUST SHOWS.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

EQUITATION/HORSEMANSHIP/RANCH PATTERN: TESTS THE RIDER'S SEAT, HANDS, AND ABILITY TO CONTROL AND SHOW A HORSE. RIDERS SHOULD DEMONSTRATE AN EVEN PACE. JUDGES EVALUATE THE METHODS USED BY THE RIDER AND EFFECTIVENESS OF THE RIDER INFLUENCING THE HORSE.

HORSEMANSHIP OVER FENCES IS SIMILAR TO HORSEMANSHIP BUT WILL REQUIRE A TROT FENCE(S), HALT, AND AT LEAST 2 CHANGES IN DIRECTION. MANNERS, STYLE OF JUMPING, MANEUVERABILITY, FLOW OF STRIDES AND BALANCE ARE ELEMENTS THE JUDGE WILL CONSIDER.

ADVANCED ENGLISH EQUITATION: ALL ENTRIES WILL WORK COLLECTIVELY ON THE FLAT AND ASKED TO DEMONSTRATE ADVANCED FLAT WORK SKILLS SUCH AS, BUT NOT LIMITED TO: LENGTHENING AND/OR COLLECTION OF STRIDE, SITTING TROT, 2-POINT, TURNING ON FOREHAND, WORK W/OUT STIRRUPS, REIN-BACK, AND/OR OTHER TESTS DEEMED APPROPRIATE BY JUDGE.
